

**MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS FOR HEADMASTER/HEADMISTRESS
MIDDLE/PRIMARY SCHOOL**

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) Academic Qualification. Graduate Degree, with a minimum aggregate of 50 percent, from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/AICTE. The Graduate Degree should be in any one of the subjects taught in the Middle/ Primary classes of that Air Force School. Those holding a graduate degree in any other subject will not be eligible. However, if such candidate holds a Masters Degree in any of the subjects taught in the School, he/she will be eligible for the post.

(ii) Professional Qualification. A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/ National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Experience. Teaching experience of at least two years as a PGT/ TGT/PRT or at least three years as a NTT or experience of at least two years as Principal/HM of an Air Force School.

(iv) Age

(aa) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled. There will be no upper age limit in the case of serving staff of Air Force Schools but they should have at least two years of residual service as on 01 July of the academic year in which they are being considered for the post.

(ab) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(ac) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(ad) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/ TGT or three years as a PRT or NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(v) Language. Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection).

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Conversant with POCSO Act, CBSE rules, NCERT etc.

(iii) Attended educational workshops.

(iv) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(v) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS FOR TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHERS (TGT)

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum mark of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under: -

TGT (Sanskrit): Sanskrit as an elective subject at Degree level

TGT (Hindi): Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

(b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially in MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS FOR MUSIC TEACHER

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) Senior Secondary with diploma in Music from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply.

(ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service Music Teacher in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) Desirable Qualifications

(i) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) Experience music,dance etc

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS FOR COMPUTER INSTRUCTOR

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known) from a recognized board with Diploma in Computer Application.

Or

(ii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B El Ed) with Diploma in Computer Application.

Or

(iii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Education (special education) with Diploma in Computer Application.

Or

(iv) Bachelor of Computer Application with 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B Ed) from any NCTE recognized institution along with six-month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.

(ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the school as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as Computer Instructor in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) Desirable Qualifications

(i) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
